Sacred Writing Time



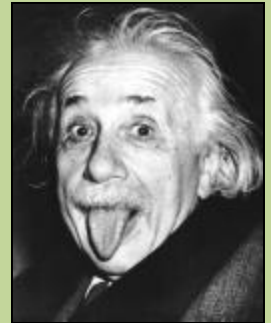
Did you come to class with an idea to write about?
