

## Instructions for Dena Harrison's Monster

1. Begin by drawing a medium-sized circle (2 inches by 2 inches) about 3 inches down the page. Use your light green colored pencil to draw this.
2. Now that you have your circle, fill it in lightly with the light green pencil.
3. Get the purple and orange colored pencils and draw short, squiggly lines all around the top of the head—alternate colors. Stick some straight lines (12 total) around the head as well as spreading them throughout. (1 inch in length)
4. This monster has slanted, angry eyebrows in light green. (1/2 inch in length)
5. Under each eyebrow, draw a small circle in red. Make the eyes bloodshot with black pupils.
6. Using light green again, draw a bulbous nose with small brown warts on it. (5 warts total)
7. Using orange, draw a slender mouth. (1 ½ inches long) Now take red and draw two fangs from the top lip. (1/2 inch long) Fill in with your red pencil. Each fang has a drop of blood at the tip.
8. Take the black pencil and draw a 1 ½ inch vertical line under the chin area.
9. Draw a 3-inch long rectangular torso. The torso is colored with alternating blue and purple stripes.
10. The two arms are green. (3 inches long) Instead of hands, it has two crab pincers.
11. From the waist down, the monster has a snake tail about 5 inches long. Take your teal pencil and color in your snake tail. Now draw medium-sized orange polka dots. (6 total)
